### Membership Grades

#### Fellow (FIEEnvSc)

Fellowship is for Members who have achieved distinction in the environmental sciences profession. Fellowship would normally require a further seven years experience beyond that required to become a Member. Application can be made subsequent to joining the Institution. No one will be admitted directly as a Fellow.

#### Member (MIEEnvSc)

This grade is for those who have achieved the professional experience comparable with chartered status in other professions. Normally a Member would have cumulated at least four years of professional work, either in, or related to, environmental science.

#### Associate (AMIEEnvSc)

For those holders of relevant degrees or equivalent qualifying experience. Often this covers those starting out in the environmental sciences sector.

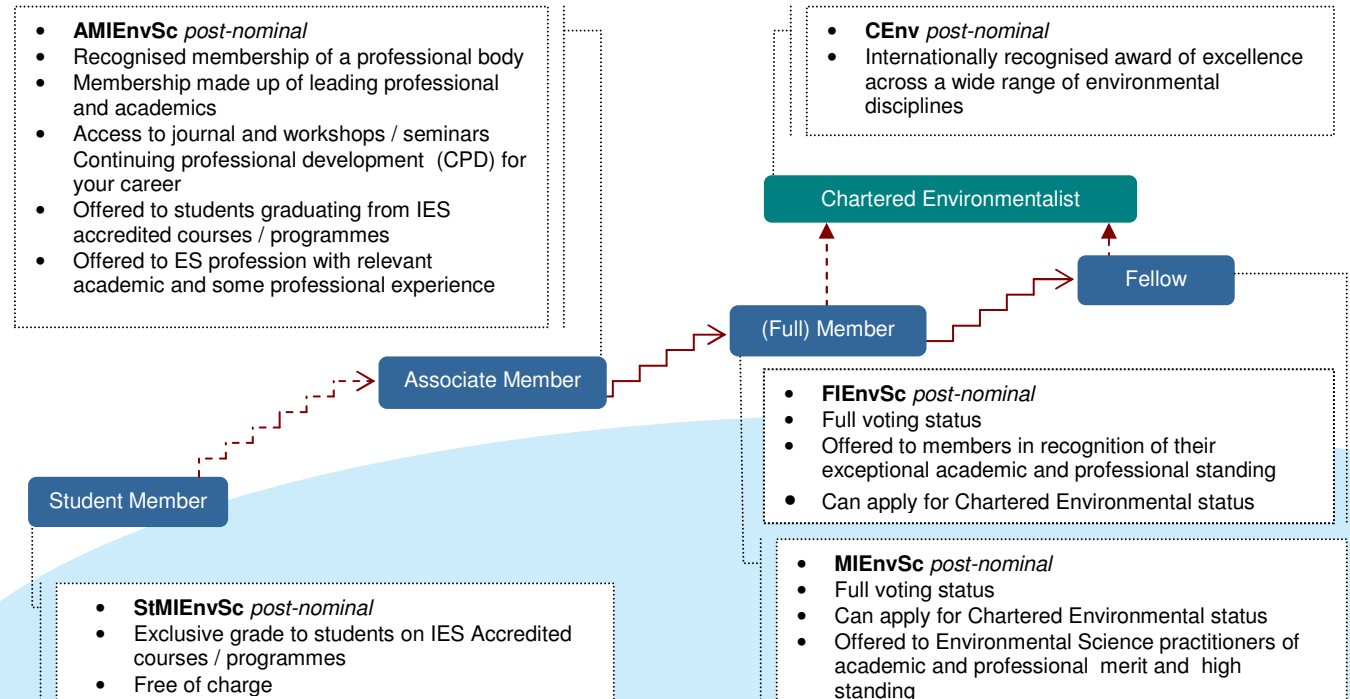
